Dear Clerk,

I am a property owner in Cape Haze FL. I am writing in opposition to the application by Environmental Utilities regarding installation of sewers in Cape Haze and the barrier islands. The Cape Haze community has very low and seasonal population density and there is no evidence that the septic systems here cause pollution. I strongly feel that this work, when it is required environmentally, should be done by the county or through a bonded bid process that will protect the consumers in this area. Furthermore, surprisingly, it is not clear what the cost would be to each household. The cost should be crystal clear based on road frontage and a per foot charge. How can a cost of \$22,000,000 be estimated without having determined the cost per household? The proposal is very concerning for many reasons and I therefore ask you to reject the Environmental Utilities application.
