RE: Docket No. 20190124-WU – Petition for limited alternative rate increase in Lake
County by Raintree Waterworks, Inc.

By Order No. PSC-2019-0459-PAA-WU, issued October 24, 2019, it was ordered that if no timely protest was filed, this docket should be closed administratively (i) once the Utility has filed the required revised tariff sheets and customer notices, and they have been approved by our staff; and (ii) staff has conducted an earnings review of the Utility pursuant to Rule 25-30.457(12), Florida Administrative Code. There was no timely protest and Raintree Waterworks, Inc. has fulfilled the ordered requirements. In addition, staff completed its earnings review on May 24, 2021, and determined that the Utility is not overearning based on information contained in its 2020 Annual Report. As a result, the Utility no longer needs to submit monthly reports related to this docket. Therefore, this docket may be closed administratively.
