On June 28, 2021, Florida Power & Light (FPL) filed a request for confidential classification pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(e) of the Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C), for information contained in FPL's response to the Federal Executive Agencies' (FEA's) First Request for Production of Documents No. 7.

FPL claims the confidential information is intended to be and has been treated by FPL as private, its confidentiality has been maintained, and its disclosure would cause harm to FPL and its customers. FPL also claims that the confidential information consists of proprietary confidential business information, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business interests of FPL. Specifically, the information contains credit and equity analyses provided by third party rating agencies, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive interests of the provider of the information, and as such, the information is protected by Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S.

Staff reviewed the documents and information included in the discovery response and concurs with FPL. In staff's opinion, the Company's request meets the criteria for confidentiality set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that FPL's request for confidential classification of the information contained in Document No. 07058-2021 be approved.
