Pursuant to Section 366.093 of the Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Florida Power & Light (FPL or Company) requests confidential classification of certain information filed in the above referenced docket, dated May 17, 2021.

The Company is claiming confidentiality of its information under Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S. Per the Statute, propriety of confidential business information includes, but is not limited to: Subsection (d) "[i]nformation concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of the public utility or its affiliates to contract for goods or services on favorable terms", Subsection (e) "[i]nformation relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of information."

FPL claims the confidential information is intended to be and has been treated as private, its confidentiality has been maintained, and its disclosure would cause harm to FPL and its customers. FPL also claims that the confidential information consists of information relating to competitive interests, and its disclosure would impair the competitive business of FPL, and information concerning bids or other contractual data, the disclosure of which would impair the efforts of FPL to contract for goods and services on favorable terms. Specifically some information is related to credit agency rating reports and equity analyses, analysis the cost-effectiveness of new DSM program participants and out data for solar generating plants.

Staff has reviewed the subject information as well as the Company's confidentiality request, and in staff's opinion, the request meets the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S.
