Good afternoon,

I would like to draw attention to the proposed increase in minimum charge for residential costumers from the base rate of \$8.34 to \$25, an amount substantially higher than the proposed base rate of \$8.99. I do not see a sufficient justification for raising the minimum charge so much higher than the base rate, especially considering that was the previous metric for what the minimum charge would be.

While it will not affect many people, it will have a negative impact on homes with solar panels, as well as the solar installers in the state. Reducing the financial incentive to add solar panels by increasing the minimum charge will cost those businesses and potentially put Floridians out of work.
