I am writing as a concerned Florida resident and customer of Florida Power & Light (FPL). I received notification that FPL intends to increase rates for customers like me. I am urging you to rethink this decision and not increase our bills.

This past year has been extremely challenging financially for many people in the state of Florida including myself. A rate increase is the last thing we need, especially for vulnerable folks who may be on a fixed income or struggling to find work. My electric bill for the past 2 months has been \$200+ when I live in a one bedroom apartment and barely use any of the flood lights. This is an outrageous amount to be paying for an apartment especially when the electricity is not being used during the day while I am away.

I urge you to reconsider this rate increase.
