Dear Commissioners,

There appears to be inaccuracies and confusion regarding names of islands, places and utilities and organizations pertaining to several documents and information in this case.

First of all there is no official Palm Island. Palm Island is a local colloquialism for some undefined part of Knight and/or Don Pedro Island.

Following is a list of names associated with this case: Knight Island, Palm Island Resort, Palm Island Estates Association (PIE), Palm Island Estates Subdivision, Knight Island Utilities (WWTP), Don Pedro Island, Don Pedro Island State Park, Bocilla Utilities (Water Utility), Little Gasparilla Island, Little Gasparilla Utilities, Little Gasparilla Water Utilities, Bocilla Chain of Islands (Thornton Key, Knight Island, Don Pedro Island and Little Gasparilla Island) and Hideaway Bay Beach Club Condominium WWTP.

Historically there were four separate islands which are now physically connected, but not all are connected to each other in regards to transportation access because access north and south is restricted by Don Pedro Island State Park. Hence the necessity for two separate barging services.

Charlotte County Future Land Use Map Series, Map #9 Barrier Island Overlay District (included) is inaccurate as well as maps and figures in the Charlotte County Master Plan and other Charlotte County Documents.


