Water Certificate No. 679-W in Marion County from Citra Highlands Water

System, LLC to Hash Utilities, LLC

On February 22, 2022, Citra Highlands Water System, LLC (Citra or Utility) filed an application for acknowledgement of the name change of the Utility. In 2021, Citra was granted Certificate No. 679-W in Marion County. The Utility's requested name change is consistent with Rule 25-30.039, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), which provides for changes in name only, with no change in the ownership or control of the utility or its assets. The Utility provided a statement attesting that there will be no change in the ownership or control of the Utility and its assets. The Utility also provided documentation from the Florida Department of State, Division of Corporations, showing the Utility's business name and registration/document number for the business. On March 24, 2022, the Utility filed a statement confirming that it mailed the approved customer notice to its customers on March 10, 2022.

Section 2.07(C)(2)(a) of the Administrative Procedures Manual grants the Director of the appropriate technical division and the Office of the General Counsel authority to approve changes of names and corporate reorganizations of regulated utilities, where no change of ownership or control or transfer of assets is involved, by notifying the Office of Commission Clerk. Staff, therefore, recommends that the request for acknowledgement of change in name is in compliance with the provisions of Rule 25-30.039, F.A.C., and that an administrative order be issued within 30 days acknowledging the change of name on Certificate No. 679-W from Citra Highlands Water System, LLC, to Hash Utilities, LLC. The resultant Order should serve as the Utility's water certificate and should be retained by the Utility. Finally, upon issuance of the Order, the docket should be closed.
