**Issue 1:** Should the Commission modify FPUC’s currently-approved PPA cost recovery factors for purposes of addressing the period-ending 2021 under-recovery of PPA costs?

**Recommendation:** Yes. Staff recommends the Commission approve adjustments to FPUC’s currently-approved PPA cost recovery factors to incorporate the Company’s period-ending 2021 under-recovery of PPA costs in the amount of \$3,790,314.


