FLORIDA CITY GAS'S REQUEST FOR CONFIDENTIAL CLASSIFICATION OF CERTAIN INFORMATION CONTAINED IN ITS RESPONSE TO THE STAFF OF THE FLORIDA PUBLIC SERVICE COMMISSION'S FIFTH SET OF **INTERROGATORIES (No. 64)**

Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes ("F.S."), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code ("F.A.C."), Florida City Gas ("FCG") hereby requests confidential classification of certain information provided in its response to the Staff of the Florida Public Service Commission's ("Staff") Fifth Set of Interrogatories No. 64 (referred to herein as the "Confidential Information"). In support of its Request, FCG states as follows:

- 1. FCG served its responses to Staff's Fifth Set of Interrogatories on September 21, 2022. Consistent with Rule 25-22.006, F.A.C., this request is being filed contemporaneously with service of those responses to request confidential classification of information contained in FCG's response to Staff's Fifth Set of Interrogatories No. 64. The following exhibits are included with and made a part of this request:
- Exhibit A consists of a copy of the confidential document on which all the information that FCG asserts is entitled to confidential treatment has been highlighted.
 - b. Exhibit B consists of a redacted copy of the confidential document.
- c. Exhibit C is a table that identifies the document for which confidential treatment is being sought and references the specific statutory basis for the claim of confidentiality. Exhibit C also identifies the declarant who supports the requested classification.

- d. Exhibit D contains the declaration of Mark Campbell in support of this Request.
- 2. The Confidential Information is intended to be and has been treated by FCG as private, its confidentiality has been maintained, and its disclosure would cause harm to FCG and its customers. Pursuant to Section 366.093, F.S., such materials are entitled to confidential treatment and are exempt from the disclosure provisions of the public records law. Thus, once the Commission determines that the information in question is proprietary confidential business information, the Commission is not required to engage in any further analysis or review such as weighing the harm of disclosure against the public interest in access to the information.
- 3. As described in the declaration included in Exhibit D, the Confidential Information that is the subject of this Request contains information relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business the provider of the information. Specifically, the Confidential Information that is the subject of this Request contains financial forecast data beyond FCG's 2023 test year, including forecasted capital expenditures and forecasted operations and maintenance expenses. This information is protected by Sections 366.093(3)(e), F.S.
- 4. Upon a finding by the Commission that the Confidential Information is proprietary confidential business information, the information should not be declassified for a period of at least eighteen (18) months and should be returned to FCG as soon as the information is no longer necessary for the Commission to conduct its business. *See* Section 366.093(4), F.S.

WHEREFORE, for the above and foregoing reasons, as more fully set forth in the supporting materials, Florida City Gas respectfully requests that its Request for Confidential Classification be granted.
