FAR NOTICE OF SECURITIES APPLICATION

The Florida Public Service Commission will consider at its November 1, 2022 Agenda Conference, Docket No. 20220160-EI, Application for authority to issue and sell securities during 12 months ending December 31, 2023, pursuant to Section 366.04, F.S., and Chapter 25-8, F.A.C., by Duke Energy Florida, LLC (“The Company”). The Company seeks Public Service Commission approval to (a) issue, sell or otherwise incur during 2023 up to \$1,500,000,000 of any combination of equity securities and other long-term obligations; and (b) Additionally, the Company requests authority to issue, sell or otherwise incur during 2023 and 2024 up to \$2,000,000,000 outstanding at any time of short-term debt securities and other obligations.
