Please also include the JEA (Jacksonville Electric Authority) on your list of utilities who are price-gouging. Our bills are typically higher during the hot summer months due to increased AC usage, and lawn watering. Summertime bills have never been higher than about \$375/month. This summer, our JEA bills (combined electric and water) have been outrageously high. \$817 for June was the highest. July through September just a few dollars below \$700 each month. JEA's explanation is that the cost of fuel has risen, increasing their costs. Yes, fuel prices are much higher than two years ago, but high enough to double our utility bills? I don't think so!
