**Docket No. 20220128-PU** – Joint petition requesting approval to establish regulatory assets, by Florida Public Utilities Company, Florida Public Utilities Company - Indiantown Division, Florida Public Utilities Company - Fort Meade, and Florida Division of Chesapeake Utilities Corporation.

<u>Issue 1:</u> Should the Commission approve FPUC's request for approval to establish regulatory assets for recording and preserving costs associated with the setup and implementation of a new customer information system?

<u>Recommendation:</u> No. The Commission should deny FPUC's request for regulatory assets for the costs associated with the duties outlined in paragraph 10 of its petition and allow the costs to be capitalized to plant. Further, any post implementation training costs should be expensed in accordance with the Uniform System of Accounts (USOA) for Public Utilities and Licensees as found in the Code of Federal Regulations, Title 18, Subchapter C, Parts 101 and 201, Plant Instructions 3.(19).
