2	CHAIRMAN FAY: All right. Next we will move to
3	Ms. Guffey for Item No. 13.
4	MS. GUFFEY: Good morning, Commissioners.
5	Sabina Guffey with the Commission staff.
6	Item 13 is a joint petition from the full
7	Florida operating units of Chesapeake Utilities
8	Corporation for approval of its 2023 swing service
9	rider rates, which allocates a portion of the
10	company's intrastate natural gas pipeline capacity
11	costs, certain transportation customers on the
12	company's system. The proposed swing service rider
13	rates include both the intrastate pipeline capacity
14	costs and the COVID-19 costs approved in the 2021
15	COVID-19 settlement agreement.
16	The swing service rider rate is a
17	cents-per-therm charge that is calculated and
18	included in the monthly gas bill and the proposed
19	rates have been calculated according to the current
20	rate classes. In the pending FPUC rate case Docket
21	No. 20220067-GU, the companies have requested to
22	consolidate its current 54 rate classes into 16
23	rate classes. If the Commission approves the

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consolidated rate classes in the rate case docket,

staff recommends that within 10 business days after

1	the Commission vote, the company should recalculate
2	the swing service rider rates for the consolidated
3	rate classes and submit revised tariffs for staff's
4	administrative approval. Staff is not aware of any
5	customer correspondence or complaints regarding
6	this docket and recommends approval.
7	CHAIRMAN FAY: Great. Thank you, Ms. Guffey.
8	With that, Commissioners, on Item No. 13, I'll
9	entertain a motion.
10	COMMISSIONER CLARK: Mr. Chairman, move that
11	all items be approved.
12	COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Second.
