

NOTICE is hereby given pursuant to Section 120.54, Florida Statutes, that the Florida Public Service Commission staff has initiated rulemaking to amend Rule 25-30.455, Florida Administrative Code, Staff Assistance in Rate Cases; Rule 25-30.456, Florida Administrative Code, Staff Assistance in Alternative Rate Setting; and Rule 25-30.457, Florida Administrative Code, Limited Alterative Rate Increase, to update and clarify the rules, and to reflect the adjustment to the gross annual revenue level required by section 367.814(1), Florida Statutes.
