Issue 1: Should the Commission authorize DEF to implement an interim storm restoration recovery charge? **Recommendation:** Yes. The Commission should authorize DEF to implement an interim storm restoration recovery charge, subject to refund. Once the total actual storm costs are known, DEF should be required to file documentation of the total storm costs for Commission review and true-up of any excess or shortfall.

<u>Recommendation:</u> The appropriate security to guarantee the funds collected subject to refund is a corporate undertaking.

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<u>Issue 3:</u> Should the Commission approve DEF's proposed interim storm restoration recovery charge tariff as shown in Attachment A of staff's memorandum dated February 23, 2023?

The Commission should approve DEF's proposed interim storm restoration recovery charge tariff, as shown in Attachment A of staff's memorandum dated February 23, 2023, effective with the first billing cycle of April 2023 and ending the earlier of full recovery or with the last billing cycle of March 2024, whichever occurs first. The interim storm restoration recovery charge should be subject to a final true-up.
