I reside in Sugarmill Florida, which is not too far from Homosass on Highway 19. We are about an hour north of Tampa, on the Gulf of Mexico side of Florida. we are some sort off the beaten path by that I mean we have no big skyscrapers We have no large manufacturing companies. But we do have Crystal River just down the road from us where the amenities makes their home. plus we have a lot of visitors in the summertime, and in the winter time we have snowbirds. With that said, I would like to tell you why I am writing this letter to you in hopes that you can help us out.

Every customer of Duke electric is outrage over the electrical bill they are getting. When I receive mine, I put it on the Internet for people to look out for their electric bill and I must have over 1000 + people that are outraged over their bill and I mean outraged. That's just the ones that has replied to my comment. There are thousands of them out out there or unhappy as hell, for the way that Duke has raise their electric bill.

I called. I got a very nice lady that I talk to. She said well the weather was cold. Yes we know it was and it was at Christmas time when you had your Ligths. Yes we but not everybody. I for one ran my Christmas lights for an hour a night and that's all . I kept my temperature down I wore long sleeve shirts and my bill was \$551 (\$355 more than the month before).and the top it off during that time frame I was not home for 15 days.

My neighbor is 89 or 90 years old he wears sweatpants, and sweatshirts His bill last month was \$173 this month over \$600 and he did not have Christmas lights on and his home is not that warm..

There's people out there that are paying \$600.00 \$800.00 more this month than they did the month before. and not all of them had their Christmas lights on at all because it didn't put any of them up. My daughter's bill was over \$800 before that it was running right around \$400.00 or less.

sometime ago they came in and put all new smart meters and ever since people have had problems after problems after problems and this one is a big damn problem they will not come out and reread the meters. Someone called the company and reported it and the response he was tolds. was you use it you pay for it and slam the phone down if that person would have told me that I would've got the names and they would've been fired cause that's not the answer you give out.

I was in a meeting last night we had over 135 people. Every one of them was outgrashed why and why is this being done and a lot of the answers, we're you go along with what the electric companies do?.

ahead to do it. What the hell are the people going to do that got these outrageous bills they got this month?

you people up there in the capital are not doing a damn thing for the lower income people in the state. all last month you had a special meeting with all the big boys to do had a special meeting with all the big boys to do something something about the insurance on the homes. What did we see? I'll tell you what we saw they are going to raise insurance on your home

by 40% to 50%. higher. And what is that going to do to people that are trying to make ends meet they always say you're only one house payment away from being homeless and it's coming down to that..

Oh, let's not forget auto insurance is going up also.

There's going to come a time and it's not too far down the road that there's Jo to be two class of people in the United States. The poor ones and the real Rich ones there'll be no middle-class people in the United States. It's coming too.

One of my neighbors had his rent raised at the first of the year he asked the landlord why and the landlord came back and said well you got a pay raise you can afford it and that's the way a lot of the damn landlord feel.

When we get a pay raise at the first of the year, the only thing that does is put you in your higher income bracket because a utility companies, your gas companies, their grocery stores, the landlords, and anybody else knows that you got a pay raise and they raise everything so they can take that pay raise away from you. Like everybody says, it only put you in a higher income bracket to pay higher taxes.

Let me pass a little information on the y'all you better sit down when you get your electrical bill this month I am single I keep my temperature set at 75–76. I received my bill today \$551.00. I know it was a little chilly, but I never change my temperature. Somebody in electrical company must wants to go on vacation and use my money to go with.. Sherry nice. Do use somebody else's money when I went on vacation maybe I can get a job with electrical company.

The bad news: The 51,000 Citrus County customers of Duke Energy will likely see their bills go up in April. The good news: The rate hike won't be as high as Duke originally forecast.

With projected prices of natural gas dropping, Duke Energy Florida on Monday trimmed proposed bill increases that likely will hit customers statewide in April.

Duke Energy Florida in January sought approval with the Florida Public Service Commission to pass along hundreds of millions of dollars in additional costs to recoup more money from customers because of higher-than-expected gas prices in 2022 and hurricane-related costs.

But in a filing Monday, Duke said lower projected gas prices in 2023 will help offset part of the proposed increases.

"Duke Energy wanted to take immediate steps to provide cost relief for our customers," Melissa Seixas, Duke Energy Florida state president, said in a prepared statement. "We understand some families are facing financial pressures and encourage anyone who needs assistance to reach out to us."

Duke Energy and other utilities rely on a benchmark of residential customers who use 1,000 kilowatt hours of electricity a month.

Under Duke's January filings, customers who use 1,000 kilowatt hours a month would have seen their bills go from the current \$165.55 to \$199.04. But with the reductions made Monday, those bills would go from \$165.55 to \$190.56.

The Public Service Commission is slated March 7 to take up proposed increases for Duke. If approved, the increases would take effect in April.
