1. What is the term of the Agreement for Temporary Territorial Variance (Exhibit B to the Petition) that you are requesting the Commission approve?

**Response:**

Pursuant to Section 3 of the Temporary Variance Agreement, the term of the Agreement will end when the Special Industrial Customer concludes its mining operations in the Eastern Expansion Project Area south of SR 64. The parties estimate that the Special Industrial Customer will conclude its mining operations in the Project area south of SR 64 in 2028. The parties will notify the PSC once the referenced mining operations are concluded.
