Good morning Mitzi,

I'm providing a response to your comments filed with the FPSC in Docket No. 20220201-WS. I want to provide you with an explanation of how this docket may affect you. First off, this proposed rate restructuring will benefit you as a customer.

Currently your Base Facility Charge for a 1 ½" meter is \$125.85 per month and the Gallonage Charge is \$9.56 per 1,000 gallons.

Under the current proposed rate your Base Facility Charge would be lowered to \$86.38 per month and the Gallonage Charge would be lowered to \$3.16 per thousand gallons.

Below is a chart for Snooze & Scoot for the six months of 2023 and how your may be affected by the change:

Please keep in mind that the FPSC staff will take into consideration the utility's filing as well as the (a) proposed settlement on overearnings on certain systems; (b) the 2023 Statutory Index already approved, and (c) repression of gallons due to any increase in gallonage charges. The final determination will be made by the Commissioners at the upcoming agenda conference. The final approved rates may be different then what was originally proposed.

Concerning the most recent outage event on April 24, 2024. As your e-mail indicated, we received your call at 5:48 p.m. and water was restored at 7:30 p.m. This was caused by a water pump failure at the water treatment plant, which was subsequently repaired. We also experienced an issue with the iron removal filtration system, which was also subsequently repaired.
