PETITION OF FLORIDA CITY GAS FOR APPROVAL TO ESTABLISH AN AFUDC RATE

Florida City Gas ("FCG" or "the Company") hereby files this Petition requesting the Florida Public Service Commission ("Commission") approve an allowance for funds used during construction ("AFUDC") rate of 5.85% to become effective July 1, 2023, pursuant to Rule 25-7.0141, Florida Administrative Code. In support thereof, FCG states as follows:

1. The Company is a natural gas utility with its principal office located at:

Florida City Gas 4045 NW 97th Avenue Doral, Florida 33178

2. Any pleading, motion, notice, order, or other document required to be served upon FCG or filed by any party to this proceeding should be served upon the following individuals:

- FCG is a natural gas local distribution company providing natural gas sales and transportation service to customers in parts of Florida and is a public utility subject to the Commission's regulatory jurisdiction under Chapter 366, Florida Statutes.
- 4. The Commission is vested with jurisdiction in this matter in accordance with Sections 366.04, 366.041, 366.05, and 366.06, Florida Statutes, which authorize the Commission to establish rates and charges for public utilities, including the relief requested herein.
- 5. This Petition, representing an initial request to establish an AFUDC rate, is submitted to the Commission, which is the affected agency, located at 2540 Shumard Oak Boulevard, Tallahassee, Florida 32399.
- 6. Pursuant to subsection (6) of Rule 25-7.0141, a utility shall not charge and accrue AFUDC without prior Commission approval. FCG herein requests the Commission approve an AFUDC rate of 5.85% (0.474898% monthly). In support of this request, attached hereto are Schedules A through C required by subsection (5) of Rule 25-7.0141.
- 7. **Appendix A** to this Petition provides the capital structure, cost rates, and weighted average cost of capital that are the basis for the requested AFUDC rate, which have been calculated in accordance with subsection (3) of Rule 25-7.0141.
- 8. **Appendix B** to this Petition provides the capital structure adjustments, including the unadjusted capital structure, reconciling adjustments, and adjusted capital structure, that are the basis for the requested AFUDC rate, which have been calculated in accordance with subsection (3) of Rule 25-7.0141.
- 9. **Appendix C** to this Petition provides the calculation of the monthly AFUDC rate using the methodology set out in subsection (4) of Rule 25-7.0141.

- 10. The AFUDC rate proposed herein is based on the actuals for the 12-month period ending June 2023. Therefore, in accordance with Subsection (6) of Rule 25-7.0141, ¹ FCG requests that the proposed new AFUDC rate be approved with an effective date of July 1, 2023.
- 11. FCG will continue to monitor the cost of capital for material changes and, if appropriate, will request a change to its AFUDC rate.
- 12. Attached as **Appendix D** to this Petition is the Affidavit of Ina Laney, Director of Financial Forecasting at Florida Power & Light Company,² certifying the truth and accuracy of the information and data provided in this Petition and supporting Schedules A through C.

WHEREFORE, FCG respectfully requests that the Commission enter its order approving the proposed AFUDC rate to become effective July 1, 2023, as set forth above and in the supporting Appendix and Schedules
