Good morning, Dorothy,

I was assigned to Docket No. 20230111-SU, and I was completing the notice review for the Utility today. The notice goes to customers and must include the docket number and title, and I noticed Okeechobee is missing an "e" in the title. The current docket title is: Application for authority to transfer wastewater facilities and Certificate No. 537-S in Okeechobe County from The Vantage Development Corporations to Vantage Oaks Utility, LLC. Before I send the notice back to the Utility with corrections, would it be possible to correct this in the docket title?

Also, I noticed there was a note in the description for Document No. 05423-2023 (the Utility's application) regarding the Utility's name. As the note says, the name should indeed be "The Vantage Development Corporation" with no "s" at the end, so this appears to be a scrivener's error as there has been no name change.
