Hi Gail,

I did receive your numbering resource notice. In the future, please file directly with the Florida Public Service Commission Clerk's Office. Instructions on how to electronically make such a filing can be found here: <https://www.floridapsc.com/filing-documents-electronically>.

Part of the process will have you enter the docket number. Items like this should go into what we call the generic docket. The docket number for the generic docket is always the year (with all four digits), followed by four "0's." So for this year, it's 20230000. Next year, it will be 20240000.

If a formal action needs to be taken, staff will move the item to a new docket, and effected parties will be notified of the revised docket number so that they can monitor and intervene as necessary.

Also, you can forward the link of your filing with the Florida Public Service Commission showing when it was filed.
