1 P R O C E E D I N G S

2 CHAIRMAN FAY: We will move to item No. 13 for
3 you. Go ahead when you are ready.

4 MR. WARD: Item 13 is a petition by Peoples
5 Gas System, Inc., for approval of the 2022 true-up,
6 projected 2023 true-up, and 2024 revenue
7 requirements and surcharges associated with the
8 cast iron/bare steel pipe replacement rider.

9 On April 4th, 2023, Peoples filed its petition
10 for a rate increase, which is pending a filing
11 decision by the Commission in December. As
12 required in the original 2012 order, Peoples has
13 proposed to move CI/BSR investments into rate base
14 that were made during January 1st, 2021, through
15 December 31st, 2023. Accordingly, the CI/BSR
16 tariff provided in the petition, and shown in
17 Attachment B, has been calculated using the
18 assumption that the Commission will approve
19 Peoples' request to move CI/BSR investments into
20 rate base.

21 Peoples was originally scheduled to complete
22 the cast iron/bare steel pipe replacements last
23 year, but it explained that it experienced delays.
24 Peoples stated that it expects to have
25 approximately 7.5 miles of cast iron/bare steel

1 replacement remaining in 2024. The replacement of
2 problematic plastic pipeline is expected to
3 continue until 2028. The proposed surcharge would
4 have a monthly bill impact of six cents per
5 residential customer who uses 20 therms.

6 Staff recommends approval of the proposed
7 surcharges.

8 CHAIRMAN FAY: Okay. Great. Thank you for
9 that presentation, Mr. Ward.

10 All right. Commissioners, any comments or
11 questions for Mr. Ward?

12 Showing none, we can take up a motion on Item
13 No. 13.

14 COMMISSIONER CLARK: Move to approve the item
15 as presented, Mr. Chairman.

16 COMMISSIONER GRAHAM: Second.

17 CHAIRMAN FAY: Okay. We have a motion and a


