2 CHAIRMAN FAY: All right. Next we will move
3 to Item No. 9, which will be presented by Ms. Wu
4 this morning.

5 Ms. Wu, you are recognized.

6 MS. WU: Good morning, Chairman and
7 Commissioners.

8 Item 9 is Tampa Electric Company's position
9 for a new account 370.10, electrical vehicle
10 charging stations, with a 10-percent depreciation
11 rate for plant asset associated with the company's
12 EV charging station pilot program.

13 This pilot was approved by the Commission
14 April 2021, which authorized the company to
15 purchase, install customer premises owned and
16 maintain 204 EV charging stations. As of October
17 2023, 50 EV charging stations have been installed.

18 Tampa Electric also owns some non-pilot
19 company used EV charging station. They are sitting
20 on company property and they are used for internal
21 purpose. Currently, these plant are recorded in
22 account 394.00 to shop and garage equipment, with a
23 14.3 percent depreciation rate. The company plan
24 to add more of these non-pilot EV charging
25 stations, and they request authority to book all

1 the non-pilot company used EV charging station in
2 the new account, 370.10.

3 Staff recommends approval of the establishment
4 of account 370.10, EV charging stations, with a
5 depreciation rate of 10 percent, and effective date
6 of October 1st, 2023, for the plant asset
7 associated with the pilot program.

8 Staff further recommends approval of the
9 company's proposed transfer of the plant and
10 depreciation reserve not associated with the
11 company's non-pilot company used EV charging
12 stations from account 394.00 to account 370.10.


