Having never received a response from staff regarding the CLK note in DN 01805-2022, the counties remained in MCD as entered. Per your email below and as confirmed by Order PSC-2022-0272-PAA-SU, we will update the docket title for Docket 20230134 and will also update MCD to only reflect Franklin County.
