Teleport Communications America, LLC.

On February 28, 2024, Teleport Communications America, LLC (TCAL) filed a request for additional numbering resources from the Number Pooling Administrator (Somos) for the TAMPACEN rate center. TCAL requested 1 block to meet the request of a specific customer for 440 consecutive numbers in the format of 813-XXX-6XXX. On February 28, 2024, TCAL's request for additional numbering resources was denied because it did not meet the utilization criteria.

On Monday, March 04, 2024, TCAL filed a petition requesting that the Commission overturn Somos' decision. In accordance with Section 2.07C.5.d(2). of the Administrative Procedures Manual (APM), staff has examined TCAL's petition and has determined the following:

- The carrier has demonstrated that it has customers in need of numbering resources;
- The carrier has shown that it will be unable to provide services to these potential customers because of Somos' denial of the numbering resources; and
- Customers will not be able to obtain service from the provider of his/her choice because the carrier does not have the numbers available.

Since the three criteria of Section 2.07C.5.d(2). of the APM have been met, please prepare an administrative Proposed Agency Action Order to be issued within seven business days of this memorandum (March 21, 2024), as outlined in the APM expedited code denial process. Somos should be directed to provide TCAL the numbering resources to meet its customer's needs in the TAMPACEN rate center.
