2 CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Let's move to Item No. 8.

3 MC. MCCLELLAND: Good morning, Commissioners.

4 This is Kate McClelland on behalf of Commission
5 staff.

6 Item No. 8 is a petition by Florida City Gas
7 230 approval of its transportation balancing
8 charge.

9 The proposed transportation balancing charge
10 is a dollars-per-therm charge that would be
11 included in the monthly gas bill for transportation
12 customers.

13 Florida City Gas balances its system in order
14 to maintain the appropriate supply of natural gas
15 and avoid imbalance penalties from intrastate
16 pipelines. Currently, all capacities and storage
17 costs associated with balancing a system are
18 recovered solely through the purchased gas
19 adjustment, or PGA, from sales customers. The
20 proposed charges would enable the utility to
21 recover its costs while allocating costs in a more
22 equitable manner from sales and transportation
23 customers.

24 Staff recommends FCG should incorporate actual
25 revenues received from the balancing charge as a

1 credit in the monthly PGA filings and in the annual
2 actual PGA true-up filing.

3 Based on review of the information provided in
4 the petition and responses to staff's data
5 requests, staff believes the proposed charge is
6 reasonable and results in an equitable allocation
7 of costs to transportation customers.

8 Staff recommends that the Commission study
9 should approve Florida City Gas' proposed
10 transportation balancing charge rider to be
11 effective once Florida City Gas completes the
12 necessary billing system adjustments.
