4. Our island was severely damaged during Hurricane Ian. Many of us are still trying to recover our lives and our homes.
5. We experience a lot of power outages here. Sewers would cause sewage backups.
6. There is only one access/exit to our island, the barge. The lines to get on and off the barge have been very long. Sometimes it takes at least an hour because of all the contractors working on hurricane damage. Adding sewer equipment to these lines would be a nightmare.

I could go on and on, but the above reasons are enough for you to deny this application.
