Secondly EU is not experienced enough to build nor maintain a septic system. 3rdly I fear what the cost will be for this sewer system from a company that has not done a septic system before. We do not want to have to pay for them to "learn" how to properly run a Public sewer system nor have to pay

multiple times for their mistakes. I believe the learning curve will be more detrimental to the environment than keeping our septic systems.

We are required to have our septic tanks emptied every 5 years. This practice more that protects our environment in keeping the nutrient levels within an acceptable range.
