On April 30, 2024, Tampa Electric Company (TECO) filed a revised request for confidential classification for Document No. 01546-2024, for certain information contained in its corrected Exhibit A. The information in the revised confidential document relates to rates, unit costs, and annual costs for metering services in TECO's Minimum Filing Requirement Schedule E-Supplemental Opt Out Study. Staff reviewed the document and concurs with TECO that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Sections 366.093(3)(d) and (e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair contractual services and harm the competitive interests of TECO.

Therefore, staff recommends that the request by TECO for confidential classification of Document No. 01546-2024 be approved.
