Pursuant to the emailed questions (the "Questions") from the Florida Public Service Commission Staff ("Staff") to DISH Wireless L.L.C. dba Gen Mobile ("Company" or "DISH Wireless") received on April 23, 2024 in Docket 20240070-TP, Company responds to the Questions as provided below. DISH Wireless reserves the right to amend, revise, and/or supplement any of the original answers it provides hereunder should there be any relevant change in circumstances.

## GENERAL OBJECTIONS

The Company objects to the Questions to the extent it seeks production of materials or information protected from disclosure by the attorney-client privilege, the attorney work product doctrine, or any other applicable privilege, doctrine, or protection from disclosure. The Company further objects to the Questions to the extent it seeks production of materials or information that the Company is not lawfully permitted to disclose to any third parties, including, but not limited to, materials that may not be disclosed to any third parties pursuant to terms of a contract, a federal or state law, or a directive from a federal or state government agency. Any inadvertent production of any document shall not be deemed or construed to constitute a waiver of any privilege or right, and DISH Wireless reserves the right to demand that the Staff return any such document and all copies thereof.

- 1. Will the company offer Transitional Lifeline service as required by Section 364.105, Florida Statutes?
  - a. Company Response: Yes.
- 2. Does the company commit to participating in the Lifeline Promotion Process per Florida administrative code 25-4.0665(3)?

- 4. Has the company been involved in any FCC or USAC enforcement actions? If yes, please provide details.
  - a. Company Response: DISH Wireless refers to and incorporates by reference its General Objections, including without limitation its objection to the production of materials or information that DISH Wireless is not lawfully permitted to disclose to any third parties. The Company has not been involved in any FCC or USAC enforcement actions related to the Lifeline program. DISH Wireless has received audit requests and other inquiries (collectively, the "Inquiries") from the Federal Communications Commission, Office of Inspector General, and Universal Service Administration Company (USAC) that are non-public and which relate to the Emergency Broadband Program (EBBP), Affordable Connectivity Program (ACP) and the Lifeline program (collectively, the "Government Programs"). Such Inquiries review the compliance of the respective programs and include but are not limited to USAC Program Integrity Audits. In addition,

USAC has issued Notices of Determination of Amounts Owed and Intent to Recoup and/or Offset Funds (the "NODs") to DISH Wireless and similarly situated service providers in connection with the Government Programs, including an NOD alleging overpayments of EBBP funds received by providers of services provided to subscribers that the government had found qualified for the EBBP under the free and reduced price school lunch program and/or school breakfast program and related Inquiries. DISH Wireless has since appealed<sup>1</sup> and to the best of its knowledge that matter is open/pending. To the best of DISH's knowledge, USAC issued substantially similar letters to other EBB service providers, including at least AT&T Mobility, LLC, which has appealed USAC's action to the Commission.<sup>2</sup> DISH Wireless is happy to answer questions about this matter under confidential treatment.
