Docket No. 20200039 - GU- Petition for approval to implement a temporary storm cost recovery surcharge, by St. Joe Natural Gas Company.

Dear Mr. Teitzman:

As the Commission will recall, following Hurricane Michael, St. Joe Natural Gas Company (St. Joe or Company) was severely damaged, along with the catastrophic damage to the homes and businesses of the Company's customers. On January 24, 2020, the Company filed a petition to recover incremental storm restoration costs associated with Hurricane Michael.

Prior to hearing, the Company reached a mutually-beneficial settlement with the Office of Public Counsel, which was submitted to the Commission for approval. Among other things, the Settlement reflected the parties' agreement that the Company should be allowed to recover \$330,115 in storm costs through the surcharge that had already been approved on an interim basis by Order No. PSC-2020-0117-PCO-GU. The storm surcharge was to extend through December 2024 at which time the surcharge will cease. Any under or over-recovery is to be handled through the Natural Gas Conservation Cost Recovery Clause. The Commission approved the Settlement Agreement by Order No. PSC-2021-0196-AS-GU, issued June 3, 2021, in Docket No. 20200039-GU.

As of May 2024, St. Joe has recovered more than the required amount. As such, the Company submits the attached revised tariff Sheet No. 83, in clean and tracked changes, reflecting termination of the surcharge. Upon approval, St. Joe will terminate the surcharge effective on the date of the revised tariff. Any over or under recovery will be handled consistent with the Settlement Agreement as approved by Order No. PSC-2021-0196-AS-GU.

Undersigned counsel has consulted with the Office of Public Counsel and it authorized to represent that the OPC concurs in this approach.
