Dear Florida Public Service Commission, I am writing to object to Duke Energy's proposed increase to energy rates which threatens to affect the energy cost for all Florida residents. Duke Energy is seeking approval for an \$820 million increase from the Florida Public Service Commission. To raise rates by 27% over the next three years, this is a \$16.48 per month increase in 2025 alone.
