7	MR. SPARKS: Good afternoon, Commissioners.
8	Tim Sparks here with the Office of General Counsel
9	to introduce Item No. 2.
10	Item No. 2 is the Office of Public Counsel's
11	motion for reconsideration or, in the alternative,
12	a motion for continuance, and the corresponding
13	request for oral argument in regard to Tampa
14	Electric Company.
15	OPC's motion was joined by the League of
16	United Latin American Citizens of Florida, Florida
17	Rising, the Sierra Club and the Florida Retail
18	Federation.
19	The motion seeks reconsideration of certain
20	controlling dates in the Order Establishing
21	Procedure, or alternatively, seeks a continuance of
22	the final hearing.
23	Staff recommends that the Commission deny
24	OPC's request for oral argument and believes that
25	the pleadings are sufficient for the Commission to

1	evaluate the motion. However, if the Commission
2	elects to exercise its discretion and hear oral
3	argument, staff recommends five minutes per side.
4	Staff also recommends that the Commission deny
5	the motion for reconsideration, as it fails to
6	raise a point of fact or law that the Prehearing
7	Officer either overlooked or failed to consider.
8	Finally, staff also recommends that the
9	Commission not grant a continuance as OPC as not
10	provided adequate grounds to depart from the
11	controlling dates established by the OEP and
12	consistent with the timeframe of Section 366.06(3),
13	Florida Statutes.
14	Staff is available for questions.
15	CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Thank you for the summary.
16	And I feel a similar way in this situation,
17	although there are some slight differences.
18	Commissioners, I will bring it to us for
19	discussion.
20	Commissioner Fay, you are recognized.
