Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Tampa Electric Company ("TECO") requests confidential classification of certain information sent in response to Office of Public Counsel's (OPC's) Ninth request for Production of Documents (PODs). More specifically, the information for which confidentiality is sought relates to POD No. 120, regarding invoices sent to TECO's associate company for IT related services.

According to TECO, the disclosure of this information would harm the ability of the company and its affiliates to do business, as the document contains information detailing rates a TECO affiliate paid for contractual services.

Staff has reviewed TECO's confidentiality request and agrees that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information included in Document to 03200-2024 be approved.
