On May 16, 2024, Tampa Electric Company (TECO or Company) filed a request for confidential treatment of Document No. 03237-2024. This document contains confidential information from TECO's response to Florida Industrial Power Users Group's First Set of Interrogatories No 5(a) and First Request for Production of Documents, Nos. 9(a) and 10. The confidential information contained within the response can be described as third-party vendor capital costs and operation & maintenance costs for various available and prospective generation technologies.

In its request for confidentiality, TECO asserts that disclosure of this information would harm TECO, as the information relates to competitive pricing, contractual data and competitive interests. Furthermore, TECO states that the Company treats the highlighted information provided in Document No. 03237-2024 as private and has not publicly disclosed it. If disclosed it may impair the Company's ability to contract for goods and services on favorable terms and also impair the competitive business of the provider of the information.

Staff has reviewed the documents and concurs with TECO that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(d) and (e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair TECO's ability to contract for goods or services, and impair its competitive business interests. Therefore, staff recommends the request by TECO for confidential classification of Document No. 03237-2024 be approved.
