Dear Mr. Fonder:

On May 16, 2024, the above-referenced utility filed an application for a LARI requesting authority to increase its rates for water service pursuant to Sections 367.0814 and 367.121, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rules 25-30.457 and 25-30.458, Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.). In accordance with Rule 25-30.457, F.A.C., the petition must be accompanied by certain information and schedules in support of the requested increase. Staff reviewed the application submitted on May 16, 2024, and determined that the utility's application did not meet an initial requirement imposed by Rule 25-30.457, F.A.C.

On May 30, 2024, staff notified the utility indicating that the application was deemed deficient. On June 14, 2024, staff determined that the utility cured its deficiency and the application is considered officially accepted. The official date of filing is established as 30 days after the official acceptance by the Commission. Therefore, pursuant to Rule 25-30.457(4), F.A.C., the official date of filing is established as July 15, 2024.

The staff engineer has determined the filing fee in the LARI to be \$200. The fee is based on the capacity of the utility's system as provided by Section 367.145(2), F.S., and Rule 25-30.020(2)(f), F.A.C. Pursuant to Rule 25-30.457(4), F.A.C., this application will be deemed denied if the utility does not remit the filing fee required within 30 days of this official acceptance letter.
