Request for Confidential Classification for Document No. 05210-2024

On June 10, 2024, Florida City Gas and Peninsula Pipeline Company, Inc. (Peninsula) jointly filed a request for confidential classification for Document No. 05210-2024 for Attachments A through F, provided in response to Staff's Fourth Data Request. Attachments A through C contain interconnection agreements, which include renewable gas producer related information. Attachment D includes the North American Energy Standards Board contract for produced commodity and related information. Attachments E and F contain information related to negotiated rates, pricing, formulas, and contract volumes. Staff reviewed the documents and concurs with the joint petitioners that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Sections 366.093(3) (d) and (e), Florida Statutes (F.S.), whereby disclosure of the information would harm the competitive business operations of FCG and Peninsula.

Therefore, staff recommends that the request by FCG and Peninsula for confidential classification of Document No. 05210-2024 be approved.
