Pursuant to Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Duke Energy Florida, LLC ("DEF") requests confidential classification of certain information provided in response to OPC's 4th request for PODs, specifically, response to POD No. 33.. The document number for the confidential filing is 02893-2024, and the document number for the request for confidential classification is 04373-2024.

DEF's response to POD No. 33 consists of sensitive business information about forecasted load growth, and the utility's plans for serving that growth. DEF asserts that the data is proprietary, and public disclosure would impair it in the marketplace.

Staff has reviewed DEF's confidentiality request and agrees that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 02893-2024 be approved.
