**RE:** Docket No. 20220064-WS - Application for transfer of water and wastewater facilities of Tymber Creek Utilities, Inc., water Certificate No. 303-W, and wastewater Certificate No. 252-S to CSWR-Florida Utility Operating Company, LLC, in Volusia County.

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Pursuant to Order No. PSC-2023-0305-PAA-WS (Order), issued October 13, 2023, CSWR-Florida Utility Operating Company, LLC (CSWR or Utility) was required: (1) to notify the Commission within 90 days of the Order that its books have been adjusted in accordance with the Commission's decision; (2) submit the executed and recorded warranty deed and a copy of its applications for permit transfer to the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and the Saint Johns River Water Management District within 60 days of the Order; and, (3) to file revised tariff sheets. The Order also advised that this docket shall be closed administratively in the event the Order becomes final and the aforementioned actions are completed.

The Order became final pursuant to Order No. PSC-2024-0079-CO-WS, issued on March 25, 2024. On June 3, 2024, the Utility provided copies of its applications for permit transfer. On June 5, 2024, CSWR provided a copy of the executed and recorded warranty deed for the land upon which its facilities are located, and a copy of the signed and executed contract for sale. On June 21, 2024, the Utility submitted the revised tariff sheets and an affidavit of mailing the customer notice stating that the notice was mailed to customers on June 11, 2024. On June 28, 2024, CSWR notified the Commission in writing that its books have been updated to reflect the Commission-required accounting adjustments. Staff has determined that the Utility has demonstrated compliance with Order No. PSC-2023-0305-PAA-WS, and requests that this docket be closed administratively.
