Pursuant to Sections 366.093(3)(c) and 366.093(3)(d), and 366.093(e), Florida Statutes (F.S.) and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Duke Energy Florida, LLC ("DEF") requests confidential classification of certain information and documents provided in response to LULAC and FL Rising's 3rd set of interrogatories (Nos. 54-78); specifically, response to interrogatory Nos. 66, 67, and 74. The document number for the confidential filing is 04412-2024, and the document number for the request for confidential classification is 06636-2024.

DEF's response to LULAC and FL Rising's response to response to interrogatory Nos. 66 and 67 contains pricing and other terms and conditions of contacts DEF entered into. In addition, certain documents in the response contain cost-related information for electric service below the substation level. The response to interrogatory No. 74 contains cost per kilowatt information from other electric utility providers Duke evaluated for comparative purposes. In its request for confidential classification, DEF asserts that disclosure of this information would impair DEF's ability to compete in the marketplace.

Staff has reviewed DEF's confidentiality request and agrees that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Sections 366.093(3)(d) and 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Therefore, staff recommends that the request for confidentiality of certain information included in Document No. 04412-2024 be approved.
