Pursuant to Section 366.093, Florida Statutes (F.S.), and Rule 25-22.006, Florida Administrative Code, Tampa Electric Company (TECO or Company) requests confidential classification of the highlighted information contained in Document No. 07165-2024, dated July 1, 2024.

The Company is claiming confidentiality of its filing under Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S. Per the Statute, propriety of confidential business information includes, but is not limited to: Subsection (e) “[i]nformation relating to competitive interests, the disclosure of which would impair the competitive business of the provider of the information.”

More specifically, the information at issue includes supporting data, amounts, and percentages of expenses allocated between Emera, TECO, and other affiliates from 2021 to 2023. The disclosure of this information could impair the competitive business interests of the entities involved.

Staff has reviewed the Company's information and confidentiality request. It is staff's opinion that the information subject to this request meets the criteria for confidentiality contained in Section 366.093(3)(e), F.S.
