2 CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: So let's move on to Item
3 No. 4.

4 Mr. Davis, you are seated and ready, let's go
5 ahead. You are recognized when you are ready.

6 MR. DAVIS: Good morning, Commissioners. I am
7 Greg Davis of the Engineering staff.

8 Item No. 4 is a petition to approve Peoples
9 Gas Systems, Incorporated, proposed numeric
10 conservation goals for the years 2025 through 2034.

11 PGS the only gas utility company subject to
12 the Florida Energy Efficiency and Conservation Act,
13 sections 366.80 through 83, and 403.519, Florida
14 Statutes.

15 FEECA requires the Commission to establish
16 numeric conservation goals for each affected
17 utility no less than every five years. As part of
18 the goal setting process, PGS performed the
19 technical potential study and an evaluation of
20 potential DSM measures to establish annual goals.

21 Overall, PGS proposed a cumulative 10-year
22 therm goal of 8.0 million therms, approximately 30
23 percent greater than its prior 10-year goal of 6.2
24 million therms.

25 Staff reviewed the technical potential study

1 and the proposed annual conservation goals, and
2 recommends that they adequately address the
3 requirements of the FEECA statute and are
4 appropriate.


