2 CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: Let's move to Item No. 8.

3 Ms. Guffey, you are recognized when you are
4 ready.

5 MS. GUFFEY: Good morning, Chairman and
6 Commissioners. Seveni Guffey with the Division of
7 Economics.

8 Item 8 is a petition from Peninsula Pipeline
9 Company requesting Commission approval of three
10 transportation service agreements with Florida City
11 Gas for gas pipeline projects located in Brevard,
12 Indian River and Miami-Dade Counties.

13 Pursuant to the agreements, Peninsula will
14 construct, own and operate the pipelines which
15 will, in turn, connect to FCG's distribution
16 system. This would allow FCG to meet the increased
17 demand for natural gas from large industrial
18 customers.

19 Other benefits of the proposed projects and
20 the agreements are that they will allow FCG to
21 access alternative gas locally produced from three
22 landfills located in Cocoa, Vero Beach and Medley,
23 and enable FCG to have a secondary source of gas.
24 Florida City Gas will pay Peninsula a negotiated
25 monthly reservation charge, which is designed to

1 recover Peninsula's cost of service.

2 Staff notes that FCG's cost of recovery --
3 cost recovery for the gas commodity will be
4 reviewed during the upcoming PGA proceeding.

5 Staff has reviewed Peninsula's petition, the
6 agreements and responses to staff's data request.
7 Staff recommends approval of this petition from
8 Peninsula.

9 Thank you.


