RE: Data request

- 1. One of the pumps failed. We had to hire a company to pump out the sludge so we could replace the pump.
 - There is one lift station.
 - Burney's was after hours.
- 2. Clay electric accounts 9046664, 9046666, 9046668 are the only accounts paid for by the Utility. Any other Clay Electric account is related to the property owned by SJRE.
- 3. Two Fold Water Engineering provides a monthly water and waste water service. They test the water quality among other things and make sure the waste water is disposed of correctly.
- 4. The monthly lawn service is \$1,000 per week for the entire property and 15% is allocated to the Utility.
 - Comcast provides internet to the property only. No charges are allocated to the Utility.
 - Waste Pro provides trash pick up for the property. No charges are allocated to the Utility.
 - Florida Pest Control is used as needed. No charges are allocated to the Utility.
- 5. St. Johns River Estates (SJRE) owns the land adjacent to the Utility which is being developed for new homes. St. John's River Estates Utility is a separate entity that owns the Utility and provides water and wastewater services to the existing homeowners.
 - United rentals provided storage for SJRE. No charges are allocated to the Utility.
 - There is no lease agreement. The Utility is allocated 15% of the insurance cost.
- 6. The prior owner of the Utility was named St. John's River Club Utilities.
- 7. There have been no plant additions or retirements.
 - The \$1,764 was from American Pipe and Tank for pumping sludge from a flooded Lift Station. See #1. It was not a repair.
 - Invoice 51353 to Two Fold Engineering was for a down payment on a new pump and it has been paid.
- 8. As far as I know all corrective actions were completed, but they were not handled by this office so I don't have any details.

- 10. 88 lots are currently in use and 12 are available.
- 11. This office does not have engineering maps available. They would be with the engineering firm.
