On July 26, 2024, Duke Energy Florida (DEF or Utility) filed a request for confidential treatment of Document No. 07510-2024. This document contains confidential information from a response to Staff's Fifth Set of Interrogatories, No. 50(b). The confidential information contained within the response includes competitive pricing data from third party vendors used by the Utility in cost-effectiveness calculations.

In its request for confidentiality, DEF asserts that disclosure of this information would harm DEF, as the information relates to competitive interests. Furthermore, DEF states that it treats the highlighted information provided in Document No. 07510-2024 as private and has not publicly disclosed it.

Staff has reviewed the documents and agrees with DEF that the nature of the information meets the requirements set forth in Section 366.093(3)(e), Florida Statutes, whereby disclosure of the information would impair DEF's competitive business interests. Therefore, staff recommends that the request by DEF for confidential classification of Document No. 07510-2024 be approved.
