2 CHAIRMAN LA ROSA: We are going to move to  
3 Item No. 6.

4 Mr. Hampson, you are recognized when you are  
5 ready.

6 MR. HAMPSON: Thank you. Good morning,  
7 Commissioners. I am Corey Hampson with the  
8 Division of Economics.

9 Item 6 is if Florida Public Utility Company's  
10 petition for approval of a special contract with  
11 the Agency for Persons with Disabilities to upgrade  
12 the electric distribution facilities at the Sunland  
13 Center in Marianna, Florida.

14 In 2023, the Agency for Persons with  
15 Disabilities notified FPUC that it had received a  
16 grant to upgrade and storm harden the Sunland  
17 Center's existing distribution facilities located  
18 behind the meter. After developing cost estimates  
19 with a third party engineering firm, FPUC  
20 negotiated a proposed special contract with the  
21 Agency, included in staff's recommendation as  
22 Attachment A.

23 In response to staff's first data request,  
24 FPUC stated that the costs and revenues associated  
25 with the project would not be recorded on the

1 regulated books of FPUC and, therefore, would have  
2 no affect on FPUC's ratepayers.

3 Staff recommends that the Commission should  
4 approve the proposed special contract between FPUC  
5 and the Agency. If approved, FPUC should record  
6 all costs and revenues associated with the  
7 improvements behind the meter of Sunland Center as  
8 below the line. Furthermore, if approved, FPUC  
9 should file the executed special contract with the  
10 Commission.


