PETITION OF TAMPA ELECTRIC COMPANY

Tampa Electric Company ("Tampa Electric" or "company"), hereby petitions the Commission for approval of the company's proposals concerning fuel and purchased power factors, capacity cost factors, Optimization Mechanism results, and generating performance incentive factors set forth herein, and in support thereof, says:

Fuel and Purchased Power Factors

- Tampa Electric projects its fuel and purchased power net true-up amount for the period January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024 will be an over-recovery of \$28,431,329 (See Exhibit No. ZDJ-3, Document No. 2, Schedule E1-C).
- 2. The company's projected expenditures for the period January 1, 2025 through May 31, 2025, when adjusted for the proposed GPIF penalty, Optimization Mechanism sharing, spread over projected kilowatt-hour sales for the period January 1, 2025 through May 31, 2025, produce a fuel and purchased power factor for the new period of 3.083 cents per kWh before the application of time of use multipliers for on-peak or off-peak or super off-peak usage. The company's projected expenditures for the period June 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025, when adjusted for the proposed GPIF penalty, Optimization Mechanism sharing, spread over projected kilowatt-hour sales for the period June 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025, when adjusted for the proposed GPIF penalty, Optimization Mechanism sharing, spread over projected kilowatt-hour sales for the period June 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025, produce a fuel and purchased power factor for the new period of 3.391 cents per

kWh before the application of time of use multipliers for on-peak, off-peak or super off-peak usage. (See Exhibit No. ZDJ-3, Document Nos. 2 and 4, Schedule E1-E).

Capacity Cost Factor

- Tampa Electric estimates that its net true-up amount applicable for the period January 1, 2024 through December 31, 2024 will be an under-recovery of \$11,236,969, as shown in Exhibit No. ZDJ-3, Document No. 1, page 2 of 4.
- 4. The company's projected expenditures for the period January 1, 2025 through December 31, 2025, when adjusted for the true-up under-recovery amount and spread over projected kilowatt-hour sales for the period, produce a capacity cost recovery factor for the period of 0.084 cents per kWh. For demand-measured customers, the factor Tampa Electric proposes to recover is \$0.31, \$0.26, and \$0.30 per billed kW for GSD/RSD, GSLDPR/GSLDTPR, and GSLDSU/GSLDTSU rate classes, respectively, as set forth in Exhibit No. ZDJ-3, Document No. 1, page 3 of 4.

<u>GPIF</u>

5. Tampa Electric has calculated that it has a GPIF reward of \$1,830,750 for performance during the period January 1, 2023 through December 31, 2023, included in Exhibit No. ZDJ-3, Document No. 2, Schedule E1-C.

Optimization Mechanism

 Tampa Electric has calculated that it is subject to an Optimization Mechanism sharing amount of \$3,122,688, included in Exhibit No. ZDJ-3, Document No. 2, Schedule E1-C. WHEREFORE, Tampa Electric Company requests that its proposals relative to fuel and purchased power cost recovery, capacity cost recovery, Optimization Mechanism sharing, and GPIF be approved as they relate to prior period true-up calculations and projected cost recovery charges.
