Hello,

I recently received the notice from Sunshine water that they are requesting increased water and sewer rates.

I do not have a history of their increase requests however I believe this occurred within the last year or possibly two.

This rate increase for the services the typical homeowner/consumer would use is equal to 16-22% increase. Average annual salary increases are in the 3% range and many of the customers are on fixed incomes, I implore you to take a close look at this increase and limit the increase to a more reasonable 3-5% if any at all.
