Re: Docket No. 20240130-WS - Application for grandfather certificate to operate water and wastewater utility in Citrus County, by CSWR-Florida Utility Operating Company, LLC.

Dear Mr. Lewis:

On behalf of CSWR-Florida Utility Operating Company, LLC ("CSWR-Florida UOC"), the following are the company's responses to the September 19, 2024 deficiency letter:

1. **System Map:** Rule 25-30.035(14), Florida Administrative Code (F.A.C.), requires a detailed system map showing the existing and proposed lines and treatment facilities, with the territory proposed to be served plotted thereon, consistent with the legal description provided. It does not appear that the system map provided with the Utility's application shows the existing or proposed lines. Please provide a system map(s) to meet this requirement.

**Response:** Exhibit E to the Application is a system map with the proposed territory plotted thereon. CSWR-Florida UOC has engaged an engineering firm to prepare a more detailed map of the existing lines. The map has been delayed as the engineering firm addresses issues arising from the recent hurricanes. CSWR-Florida UOC will provide the more detailed system map as soon as it becomes available.

2. **Permits:** Rule 25-30.035(16), F.A.C., requires a copy of all current permits issued by the Department of Environmental Protection (DEP) and water management district. The application states it is for water and wastewater services; however, the DEP water permit was not included in the application. Please provide the water permit to meet the requirement.

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**Response:** CSWR-Florida UOC has provided a copy of all current permits issued by the Department of Environmental Protection and water management district. Exhibit G to the Application includes copies of Department of Environmental Protection Domestic Wastewater Treatment Facility Permit No.: FLA011869 and Water Use Permit No.: 20 004153.014 issued by the Southwest Florida Water Management District. There is not a separate water permit required by DEP.
